Chase Challenge Park Race June 23rd 2007 Tamworth



TRAVEL: From all major roads into Tamworth follow the brown signs for the Snowdome

PARKING: Please follow marshals instructions on where to park in the snowdome carpark

ASSEMBLY: Registration, Enquiries and Download will be located in Starbucks within the snowdome. Please avoid entering the snowdome in muddy shoes and clothing.

ENQUIRIES: Available for general enquiries, lost property, lone runner keys, First Aid.

COURSES: Course A – Men's Open, Men's Vets – 3.4km
Course B – Women's Open, Women's Vets, Men's S-Vets – 3.1km
Course C – Women's S-Vets, Men's 60 + Women's 60+, Men's + Women's Juniors - 2.3 km
Course D – Novice - 1.6km
(competitors are welcome to run up or down age classes as they wish)
Sportident Electronic Punching will be used

FEES: Costs £5.00 + £2.00 surcharge if not a BOF member. SI hire £ free £3.00 discount for juniors EOD: Will be available for all courses

SI CARD HIRE: Will these be available from Registration

Start times 6.25 - 7.30 – just go to the start when you are ready.

START and FINISH: 5 minute walk to the start, please follow taped route past the finish which is located on the footbridge adjacent to the Snowdome

Map: The map is drawn to IOF sprint specifications at a scale of 1:5000 with a contour interval of 2.5m. Competitors should make sure they are familiar with the sprint specification impassable cliff, fence and wall symbols (thicker than usual black lines) which means you are not allowed to cross the feature even if you can; that is, the feature may be physically crossable but crossing it will lead to disqualification.

Safety: Red lines between controls have often been drawn straight even when they cross buildings, private land, and other impassable features. The red line on the map does not mean you are allowed to follow that route; it is merely to help you locate the next control. The races cross roads including one-way streets. Look all around and listen before stepping off the pavement. More likely is a collision with a pedestrian who will not be expecting you. Be considerate and RUN WIDE AT EVERY BLIND CORNER.

Out of Bounds: All Dual Carriageways are out of bounds

CONTROL DESCRIPTIONS: Loose control description sheets will be available
