

**Walton Chasers Orienteering Club**  
**Regional Event**  
**North Sherbrook, Stafford**  
**Sunday 11<sup>th</sup> February 2007**

**Directions.** The assembly area is at Haywood Park Farm just off the A513 Stafford to Rugeley road between Milford and Wolseley Bridge. It is one mile west of the JK2005 Day 2 site. SJ994210.

**Parking.** In a reasonably well drained field adjacent to the assembly area. The parking charge is £1.50. This is the amount charged by the farmer for the use of his field. The furthest part of the car park is no more than 500m from the start.

**Please walk from the car park to the Assembly field via the opened gaps in the fence and not over the fence.** This is a specific request from the farmer. Parking fields are very kindly made available to us by farmers and it is our duty to make sure no damage is done. Thank you.

**Enquiries.** These will be located centrally in the assembly area. General information will be displayed here. Lone runners may leave keys.

**Dogs.** Must be kept on a lead at all times. There are sheep in adjacent fields.

**Terrain.** Typical Cannock Chase; it is fast, runnable with plenty of climb.

**The competition area is undermined and liable to mining subsidence. Areas marked out of bounds must be strictly avoided. Care must be taken as new fissures could suddenly occur away from any areas marked out of bounds.**

**Map.** Map scales: courses 1 to 5: 1:15,000                      Courses 6 to 14 & CC: 1:10,000

Badge course maps will be bagged but not sealed.

Colour coded maps will be pre-marked and bagged but not sealed

**Control descriptions.** These will be available at the start ( -3min box) except for white and yellow CC courses which will be issued at Registration.

**First Aid.** St John Ambulance will be in attendance.

**Traders.** Ultrasport will be present

**Entry on day.** There is no Badge EOD.

**Colour Coded courses.** The following courses are available Entry-on-day only:

White, Yellow, Orange, Light Green and Red.

CC Registration forms will be available at the Registration tent.

Entry fees

Starts: 10:30 – 12:00

**String course.** This is located 50m to the north of the Download tent. Entry is free. Starts 10:30 to 12:30  
There are some dormant beehives in the area that must not be approached. They will be taped off.

**E-cards.** Sportident will be in use for all Badge and Colour Coded courses. Hire e-cards will be available for collection from Registration. It is essential that competitors run with the e-card that is registered to them.

**Clear station.** All e-cards must be cleared before use at this event. The clear station is positioned in the field 10 metres to the right of the exit from the field to the start.

**Start.** It is 200m from the gate exiting the field into the forest. This gate is also used for the final run-in so it is requested that competitors and spectators stand clear of this gateway.  
Call up is at -4 minutes. It is a punching start but you must respect your allocated start time.

**Finish.** This is in the assembly area. The Download is adjacent to the finish. Please download as soon as you finish.  
Courses close at 15:00

**Results.** These will be displayed in the assembly area near to the Download tent and will be posted on WCH website [www.walton-chasers.co.uk](http://www.walton-chasers.co.uk) Colour coded results will be available by post by completing a self addressed envelope at Registration and including 30p.

**Safety.** It is very strongly recommended that whistles be carried. In the event of adverse weather cagoules may also be required. Competitors who are travelling alone are advised to leave car keys etc, suitably labelled at Enquiries. All competitors take part at their own risk.
