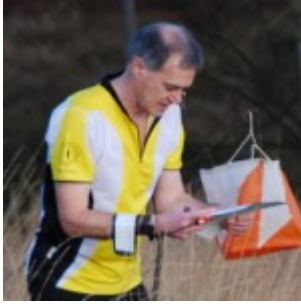


WMOA Compass Sport Cup & Trophy Heat

Terrain:

Brereton Spurs is a mainly wooded area with an extensive path network and as the name suggests, plenty of spurs and contour detail. At this time of year the bracken is down, making the area fast under foot. The longer courses will venture onto Brereton Hayes which has a mixture of open and wooded land, with patches of intricate contour detail and areas of dense woodland

Saftey:

- Full leg cover is required for all competitors (no shorts)
- In case of bad weather competitors may be required to wear(carry) water or wind-proof tops.
- Cannock Chase generally has been undermined and liable to mining subsidence.

Areas marked out of bounds close to known in-filled fissure lines must be strictly avoided. Care must be taken as new fissures could suddenly occur away from these known areas.
