Road Crossings – there are two road crossings on the Green, Blue and Brown Courses. They are timed out up to 2 mins and manned. Traffic is fast moving on this road. Take extra care and follow any instructions from the marshalls.

There is an area towards the end of all courses except white & yellow (around controls 181 & 150) where there is some old barbed wire on the ground - please take care. There's not lots, but too much to remove/tape.

There is also a quarry cliff top which those on Blue and Brown courses may come across and will be taped off with yellow/black tape.

Safety: This area is undermined and liable to subsidence. Areas marked out of bounds must be strictly avoided. Care must be taken as new fissures could suddenly occur away from these areas. Competitors take part at their own risk and are responsible for their own safety. There will be a whistle check at the start – no whistle, no go.

Start – The route to the start is approx. 800m walk with a small fence to cross.

Call up will be at -4 minutes. There will be a punching start but you must still arrive in time for your allocated start time.

White, Yellow and Score do not need a pre allocated start time.

Start times for CSC will be available to view at Enquiries and in the start area.

Finish – For those running in the Compass Sport Cup and Trophy, maps will be collected until 12.30 at the finish. Club Captains can collect the maps after this time. There is a marked route to the assembly field and download. All competitors must report to download even if you do not finish your course. Courses close at 2.30pm. St John Ambulance will be at the finish and a limited amount of water/cups.

Registration – The only EOD is for the White and Yellow course and the 1hr score event. White and Yellow courses will be given their map and control description. Score event entries will receive a token to be taken to the start.

Club Captains – Please go to enquiries where you will be able to collect: dibbers you are hiring, maps and control descriptions for pre entered white and yellow courses, entry slips for pre entered score, pay any outstanding fees. We may also need final information from you regarding SI card numbers etc.

Any maps not collected from the finish will be taken to enquiries.

Extreme Weather – should there be a need to postpone the event due to the weather making it unsafe to go ahead the decision will be made at 7am. We will then get the information on the website www.walton-chasers.co.uk and email club captains as soon as possible.

Stalls – there will be Ultrasport, Podium Catering (hot food and drink) and the West Midland Junior Squad fund raising cake stall.
