

## Walton Chasers – House Teams Competition

### Rules of Engagement

Valid for Calendar Year 2012

#### House Team Membership

1. The club membership will be split across four house teams, called:
  - a. North
  - b. South
  - c. East
  - d. West
2. Team allocation is achieved by sorting the membership list alphabetically by surname (so that family members are split between different teams).
3. New members are allocated to teams on a rotating basis by the membership secretary as their membership applications are received
4. Club Captain will nominate Team Captains for each team, whose responsibility it will be to encourage team members to attend events and score points.
5. Lapsed club members (last years members who have yet to renew) will be allocated to teams and have until the end of February to renew their membership; otherwise any points scored at events attended will not be counted.

#### Qualification for Points

6. In order to qualify for team points, runners must be
  - a. BOF registered as club members (either individual/family or an affiliate/schools member)
  - b. Listed in the event results as a WCH competitor
7. Events that qualify for points are:
  - a. Any WCH event where SI cards are used to track results
  - b. Any non-WCH event where the results are published to the BOF website
8. Leagues run over a calendar year with a trophy to be awarded at the Annual Prize Giving.

#### Points Scheme

9. Points will be allocated as follows, regardless of the course run:

	Level A Event (x4)	Level B Event (x3)	Level C Event (x2)	Any other event (x1)
<b>1<sup>st</sup> Finishing Chaser</b>	40 points	30 points	20 points	10 points
<b>2<sup>nd</sup> Finishing Chaser</b>	32 points	24 points	16 points	8 points
<b>3<sup>rd</sup> Finishing Chaser</b>	24 points	18 points	12 points	6 points
<b>Any other finishing Chaser, planner or controller</b>	16 points	12 points	8 points	4 points
<b>Any retired, disqualified or non competitive Chaser</b>	4 points	3 points	2 points	1 point

10. **Please note:** Running a course which you find easy simply for the sake of winning a greater number of points for your team is, sadly, within the rules of the competition. However, it is not within the *spirit* of the competition, and if anyone is deemed to be using this tactic, the committee reserves the right to impose a suitable penalty!
