



Orienteering On Cannock Chase

Hednesford Camp Regional and WMOA League Event Sunday October 14th 2012

- Directions to event: From A34 at Pottal Pool roundabout GR: SJ 971143, 6 miles SE of Stafford, turn towards Rugeley. After 1.8 miles, turn right into Marquis Drive. After 0.4 miles, pass straight over the crossroads. Continue on Marquis Drive then Brindley Heath Road for 0.8 miles, then turn left onto a forest track.
- Parking: Hardstanding at the end of a forest track, GR: SK 006144. Assembly Area will be in same location as car park. Walk from Assembly Area to start, approximately 200m.
- Courses: Full range of Colour Coded courses:
White, Yellow, Orange, Light Green, Short Green, Green, Blue and Brown.
- Registration: 10:00 to 12:00
- Start: 10:30 to 12:30
- Entry Fees: Seniors £9 (less £2 for current BO members)
Juniors £2
Entry on the day only
- Type of punching: Sport-Ident (SI) Electronic
- Hire of E-card: Seniors £1 Juniors 50p
- Terrain: Open heathland and mixed woodland with some intricate contour detail and complex path network. At this time of year there is a certain amount of unmapped seasonal undergrowth, which may affect route choices in some instances.
- Map: 1 : 10,000 Control descriptions will be available at Registration.
- Toilets: Toilets are available in the Assembly Area.
- Dogs: Dogs to be on leads please.
