## Final Details

### Directions to event

From A5 south of Cannock, take the B4154 (Lime Lane) towards Pelsall. The event will be signposted from junction of Lime Lane with Wyrley Lane (SK022053)

### Car Park

Hardstanding at Fishley Leisure Centre (postcode WS3 5AE). The Assembly Area will be in the same location as the start and finish. Walk from car park to assembly area approx 1 km (15 minutes walk).

Parking cost is £1 per car.

### Assembly Area

Enquiries, Registration, First Aid, Toilets, Start, Finish and Download are all situated at or near the assembly area.

As there are currently no traders expected at the event, water will be provided at the finish.

Please keep dogs on leads at all times.

### Tents

There is space on the assembly field for club or personal tents. A bag drop tent will also be provided adjacent to the finish and download; all items are left at the owners risk.

Anyone with tents who would like to drop them at the assembly area before proceeding to the car park is asked to contact the organiser before the event.

## Registration and Start Times

Registration will be open between 10:00 and 12:00. Start times are from 10:30 to 12:30.

There is no pre-allocation of start times, however runners on Yvette Baker Competition courses will not be allowed to start within 4 minutes of a competing runner from the same club on the same course. Please follow any instructions provided by the start team.

## Yvette Baker Competition Rules

Full rules for the Yvette Baker Competition can be found on the British Orienteering website under Events -> Rules -> Competition Rules L. Specific rules on eligibility are as follows:

Green any junior (i.e. M/W18 or under)

Light Green any M/W14-  
any M/W16+ who has not at any time achieved a gold badge time in the M/W16 (or higher) age class at any one of the British Long Distance Championships, JK Day 2 (Saturday), JK Day 3 (Sunday), Northern Championships, Midland Championships, Southern Championships, or finished within 125% of the winner of the respective M or W class on the Light Green (or Green) course at any previous Yvette Baker Trophy Final

Orange any M/W12-  
any M/W14+ who has not at any time achieved a gold badge time in the M/W14 (or higher) age class at any one of the British Long Distance Championships, JK Day 2 (Saturday), JK Day 3 (Sunday), Northern Championships, Midland Championships, Southern Championships, or finished within 125% of the winner of the respective M or W class on the Orange (or higher) course at any previous Yvette Baker Trophy Final

Yellow any M/W10  
any M/W12 or M/W14 who has not at any time achieved a gold badge time in the M/W12 or M/W14 (or higher) age class at any one of the British Long Distance Championships, JK Day 2 (Saturday), JK Day 3 (Sunday), Northern Championships, Midland Championships, Southern Championships, or finished within 125% of the winner of the respective M or W class on the Yellow (or higher) course at any previous Yvette Baker Trophy Final

Pairs may compete on the Yellow course. As a minimum requirement, neither member of the pair may have achieved a gold badge standard at any of the events listed in the Yellow section above.

Shadowing of competitors is not allowed.

No runner may run competitively more than once per match.

Any club running a competitor on a course for which they are not eligible will be disqualified. i.e. the whole team, not just the competitor concerned.
