Facilities & Assembly Area The Assembly area will be in the grounds of the football club. The Football Club are opening their lounge bar for us. There will be hot and cold drinks and light snacks available to purchase. This will be a nice venue to relax in before and/or after the event but please remove all muddy clothes and footwear. (Outside toilets are available in the assemble area)

The walk from Assembly Area to the start is approximately 700 m over the road bridge and will be taped and signed.

Safety:

Chasetown Country Park is used by members of the public for a variety of activities. There are a number of car parks and access roads where there will be slow moving vehicles. Competitors will need to be aware and take care.

The area also has an operating narrow gage steam railway, with crossing points across which some of the courses pass. These will be manned and time out will be allowed. Please take care and pay attention to the marshal's instructions.

- Competitors take part at their own risk.
- Whistles must be carried.
- Full leg cover is required for all competitors (no shorts)
- In case of bad weather competitors may be required to wear (carry) water or wind-proof tops.
- All starting competitors must report to download irrespective of whether courses are completed or not
- St John's ambulance will be providing first aid cover and will be present at the assembly area
