- Directions to event: The event takes place within the grounds of the Shugborough estate
GR: SJ 97528 21078. The nearest postcode is ST17 0UP. Access to the event is from the A513, **please use the main entrance to the Shugborough estate adjacent to Milford Common**. Please note that the **A513 is CLOSED BETWEEN STAFFORD (A32/A513 junction) AND MILFORD**. You can reach the main Shugborough entrance from the east using the A513 from Wolseley Bridge or from the west, you should come through Brocton from the A34.
- Parking: £1 per car. Parking will be on a field before the main car park, please be guided by the marshals. Registration, download and toilets are located in the Outdoor Education Centre, a short walk from the parking area.
