- Venue:** **Beaudesert Outdoor Activity Centre and Forest**
- Date:** **Sunday 13 Jan 2019**
- Directions:** The event will not be signed as there are so many routes in. The grid reference of the Beaudesert Outdoor Activity Centre is SK 050130; Postcode WS15 4JJ. Entry to the site is via Chestall Road at Cannock Wood only, here: [Google map](#) or [Street Map](#). Take care at the entrance. Even though it looks like you drive straight on from Chestall Road, officially you turn off the road as the road bends left to become Holly Hill Road
- Parking:** In the Activity centre, follow directions above. No height restrictions on parking.
- Registration:** 10.00 to 12.00
Please fill in a registration form (provided by the car parking team) then take it and your dibber (if you have one) to registration
- Start Times:** 10.30 to 12.30 (courses close 2:00pm)
- Entry Fees:** EOD only: Seniors £8, (non British Orienteering members £10), Juniors £3
- Punching:** SportIdent with mixed electronic punching i.e. SIAC enabled or traditional dishing

- Map:** Map as used for JK2018, survey by Dave Peel. Scale 1:10,000 5m contours
1:5000, 5m contours for White and Yellow
Pre-marked maps on waterproof paper.
- Terrain:** Mainly runnable wood, but with undergrowth and brashings in some parts.
- Facilities:** Toilets, showers, first aid, Ultrasport, Podium Catering.
- Safety:** The area includes some very marshy areas, marked OOB on the map. An Axe throwing competition in the Outdoor Activity Centre, marked OOB on the map and taped on the ground from potential approach direction.
Whistles must be carried. Full leg cover is required.
- Dogs:** Unfortunately, no dogs allowed in the Activity Centre or car park. If you have a dog, then you can park offsite in the Castle Ring car park 600 m West of the entry gate. Then walk in via Gate at NE side of Castle ring. Please remember though, your dog cannot come on to the event site.
- Safety and Risk:** A comprehensive risk assessment will have been carried out by the organiser, but participants take part at their own risk and are responsible for their own safety during the event.

Insurance: Please note that if you have competed in three orienteering events and not joined an orienteering club that is a member of British Orienteering then you are not covered by our public liability insurance.
