

## Regional Event and West Midlands League Event

Venue: Chetwynd Coppice & Brereton Spurs, Cannock Chase

Date: Sunday 21st November 2021

**Directions:** Signed from A460 Rugeley to Hednesford Road, on the edge of Rugeley, Stile Cop Road to

the south. Stile Cop Road is also signed for "Stile Cop Cemetery". The postcode of the cemetery next to the lane entrance to the parking field is WS15 1ND, but please note this may take you into the nearby housing estate from which there is no access. Area as used for

**Parking:** Lane entrance is "Coppice Lane", then in a well-drained field as for the JK.

Dogs are permitted.

**Start Times:** 10.30 to 12.30 Hrs.

Entry Fees: Pre-entry for the longer and WM league courses: Seniors £10, Juniors £3. Family entry (2

adults + juniors) £20. SI card hire is free.

Please note that the event needs to cover three separate access fees.

**Punching:** SportIdent with mixed electronic punching, i.e. SIAC or traditional dibbing. **Competition:** West Midlands League Event and Colour Coded. Beginners are welcome.

**Courses:** Colour Coded, White, Yellow, Orange, Light Green, Short Green, Green, Blue, and Brown.

Map: Map as used for JK2018, survey by Dave Peel, recent updates.

Scale 1:10,000, 5m contours. Pre-marked maps on waterproof paper.

**Terrain:** Mainly runnable wood, but with undergrowth and brashings in some parts. Southern area

includes well contoured series of spurs and re-entrants

**Facilities:** Toilets, first aid, other traders may confirm.

**Safety:** The area includes Chetwynd Coppice which in the past has had mining operations, especially

on the east side. Two known shafts are fenced off. The area can be subject to subsidence. Whistles must be carried. Full leg cover is compulsory. Both will be checked before you

start.

Safety and Risk: A risk assessment will have been carried out by the organiser, but participants take part at

their own risk and are responsible for their own safety during the event.

**Insurance:** Please note that if you have competed in three orienteering events and not joined an

orienteering club that is a member of British Orienteering then you are not covered by our
