Directions to event: From the A34 roundabout with Pottal Pool Road, south of Stafford, head east up Broadhurst Green Road. Take the second right turning onto Marquis Drive and then continue straight over the next crossroads on to Brindley Heath Road. The entrance to the car park is approx. 500m south of the Marquis Drive Visitors Centre and will be marked with feather flags.

- 60 minute time limit
 - 29 standard controls
 - **10 points each**

 - **20 points if you catch him.**

Safety:

- The slope to the south of the area is very steep and can be slippery in wet weather. Please take extra care in this area.
- Hednesford Camp is a public area and is popular with local walkers. Please be considerate (and watch out for small kids on their new Christmas presents)
- This area is undermined and liable to subsidence. Areas marked out of bounds must be strictly avoided. Care must be taken as new fissures could suddenly occur away from these areas.
- Full leg cover is mandatory.
- In the event of bad weather, cagoules will also be mandatory. In this situation, signs will be posted at registration
