Chillington Hall, West Midlands League Event

- Directions to event:** Registration will be in estate buildings close to the car park situated behind **Chillington Hall**. at GR SJ 861 069 Postcode: WV81RE. All the event administration will be in estate buildings behind the main Hall. Access to the assembly area is via the main Chillington Hall entrance. Chillington is best approached from the north and will only be signed from this direction. From North travelling from Stafford on the A449. At Gailey roundabout head West joining the A5 (Telford) for 0.5 miles. Turn left heading South on Claygate Road, continue for about 1 mile, bearing left onto Tinkers Lane. This is a narrow lane with passing places, take care!. After about 3/4 mile go straight across the cross roads, still on Tinkers Lane and follow the 'O' signs.
- Light refreshments will be provided in the estate buildings.
- Parking:** Car parking will be part hard standing, and part grass fields at the rear of the main hall please park as directed by marshals. £1 for parking.
- Courses:** String, White, Yellow, Orange, Light Green, Green, Blue and Brown & Score - Entry on the Day only.
- Registration:** 10:00 - 12:00 **Start:** 10:30 - 12:30
- Entry Fees:** Seniors **£9** for BOF members.(£11 non BOF) Juniors **£2**. Car parking **£1** (Payable on entry to car park)
- Type of punching:** Sport Ident (Si) Electronic
- Hire of E-card:** Seniors £1 Juniors 50p (£30 charge for any loss of dibber)

Terrain: A recently updated map has been produced centred on the beautiful Georgian house at the heart of this traditional English country estate. Combination of mixed woodland with a good path network and detailed vegetation changes, including some forest blocks with some challenging point features. The forest is separated from the traditional estate parkland by a large lake. The courses have been planned in line with a full length long distance event with long legs and lots of route choice to avoid dense undergrowth and make the most of the beautiful lake and parkland

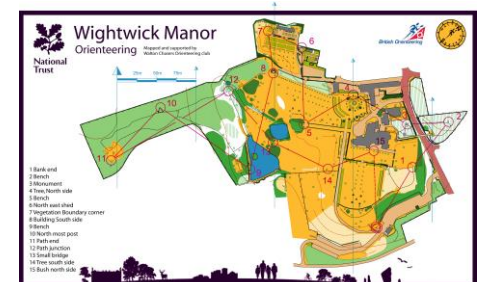
