Oldacre Valley

Saturday 7 January 2017

- Parking at: Chase Road Corner Car Park, Chase Road, Brocton
OS ref SJ980175
- Facilities: Sorry, no toilets on site
- Terrain: Oldacre Valley is an area typical of Cannock Chase, with varied terrain of forest, scattered trees and open land. The area has a central valley and is hillier and steeper to the north and flatter in the south. There is a multitude of paths of varying width.
- Safety: Whistles must be carried and long trousers are compulsory. Goggles may be compulsory depending on the weather conditions. *This area is undermined and liable to subsidence. Areas marked as out of bounds must be strictly avoided. Care must be taken as new fissures could suddenly occur away from these areas. Competitors take part at their own risk.*
- Entries: No entries on the day. See the separate start time listing for your allocated start time. Dibbers will be available to borrow at download if you don't have one.
- Start: The start is located on the opposite side of Chase Road from the car park, please be aware of traffic on Chase Road when crossing to start and from finish to the car park. Start times are from 10.30-11.30 please be at the start for your allocated time, otherwise you could have a long wait for a slot. Courses close at 1.00pm.
- Warning: The area and car park are used by members of the public including dog walkers, bikers and horse riders, please be considerate of other users.
- Courses and lengths: Yellow 2.0 km – W/M12 and younger
Orange 2.3km –W/M14
Short Green 2.7 km – W/M16, M70+, W60+
Green 4.5km – W18, Women's Open, W40-W55, M60+M65
Blue 6.5 km – M18, Men's Open, M40-M55

Your **handicap** has been calculated by Club Captain, Cath Williams. Everyone is given a handicap time and there is a Winner trophy and Handicap trophy for each class. The person who is awarded the Winner trophy is not eligible to receive the Handicap trophy as well.
